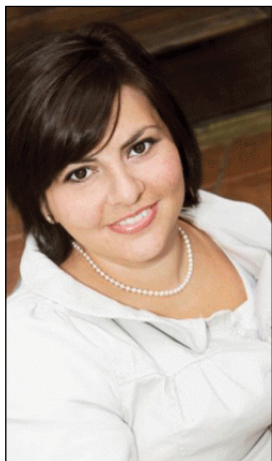



Adrienne Brennan, PhD
