Before joining Jefferson Neuro., Dr. Schwehm worked for five years as a Clinical Assistant Professor with LSU Health Sciences Center, coordinating assessment and treatment for youth in secure custody. She had previous clinical and administrative appointments at the Mississippi State Hospital and the VA Medical Center in Jackson, Mississippi.

Dr. Schwehm works with children 12 and older, adults, and geriatric clients. She offers cognitive-behavioral, empirical approaches to the treatment of anxiety, depression, post-traumatic stress, ADHD and behavior problems, alcohol/drug abuse, marital difficulties, and adjustment to chronic pain and medical diagnoses.

Assessment services include evaluation of possible ADHD and learning disabilities, cognitive complaints and suspected dementia, psychological diagnosis and treatment recommendations, the role of mental health issues in symptom presentation, adjustment to pain, and psychological risk factors for medical procedures.

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
